### 1 Getting Started

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- Fill out the intake questionnaire and send your advisor an up-to-date CV.
- Schedule your initial video consultation with your advisor.

### 2 Initial Consultation

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- Create a calendar for all your required work, including application deadlines and completed draft target dates.
- Discuss your background, interest in pursuing the degree you are applying for, and what makes you a compelling candidate for admissions.
- Create a detailed outline for your first essay.

### 3 Write Your Essay

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- Write the first draft of your first essay based on the outline you developed together with your advisor in the initial consultation.

### 4 Revision & Follow-Up

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- Once you complete your draft, your advisor will revise it and provide you a critique with suggestions for improvement.
- You can follow-up with your advisor over email or video conference to ask any questions or iron out lingering issues.

You and your advisor will repeat steps 2-4 for as many essays as you need to write. Your advisor will help guide you through questions about what writing can be repurposed from one essay to the next, and what you will want to write from scratch. Your advisor will check in with you periodically throughout the process to discuss upcoming deadlines, your progress in the writing process, and how you are doing in general. Once you finish the final draft of your last essay, your advisor will answer any final questions from your time working together. At the end of this process, you will have completed all of your admissions writing and produced effective essays that both display your unique qualities and position you as a strong applicant.
